

THE 10 COMMANDMENTS

FOR ACTLAB STUDENT WEBSITES

1. **Site must include these four pages:**
 - **home:** says something about you
 - **project one, two, and three:** document projects
2. **Documentation of projects must include show & tell:**
(such as videos, sound recordings, or images)
 - media^ show project, and optionally the making of
 - text tells your thoughts on a project, describes it, the making of, and its relationship to the course topic
3. **All site content must be on the ACTLab server**
4. **Every page must have navigation:**
 - buttons, menus, or links to the site's main headings, homepage
 - a link to the ACTLab homepage
5. **Everything must work:** no broken links or missing images
6. **Videos must be exported with Quicktime Pro using the Broadband Medium setting** or another setting with a data rate of 300kbps or less
7. **All videos and sound files must stream automatically** – test this using a computer *not* connected to the UT Network
8. **Content images must be low-to-medium quality JPEGs** (20-50 out of 100)
9. **Images must be saved at their site display resolutions**
10. **Your site must not use browser window controllers** (new or resize)
