
Problem Statement

Organic architecture was the style that Antonio Gaudi used with a combination of steel and tile. By using the organic style and these two materials, I developed my mask.










Artist Loft




Mundane




Concept

Designing with a Rubik's Cube Puzzle as my mundane object, I moved and shifted the fifty-four individual squares to come up with a plan for my institution.



































Movable structure


Design a structure that can be dismantled and reassembled to travel throughout the United States. The structure has to be able to fit in a Uhaul and be assembled with no heavy equipment.
